- 1) Softball BC rules will apply unless otherwise noted.
- 2) Guaranteed 5 games (4 round robin, 1 playoff).
- 3) Proof of age may be requested.
- 4) No pre-game warm-up on the infield.
- 5) It is the responsibility of each coach to check and confirm the game schedule posted on the Board. If there is a discrepancy between TeamSnap and the Board, the Board shall prevail. Schedules can be altered at the discretion of the tournament committee.
- 6) Teams may bat 9 or unlimited substitution (at the coach's discretion). Please inform the Umpires at the Plate Conference.
- 7) Round Robin Games:
 - "Home" team determined by coin-toss at home Plate Conference.
 - No new inning will start after 1 hour 15 minutes, drop dead game time is 1 hour 30 minutes
 - When time has expired (1 hour 15 minutes), if an inning has commenced, it must be completed until home team is ahead or 3 outs has occurred.
 - Once the home team takes the lead at 1 hour 15 minutes, the inning is considered complete.
 - If the inning has not been completed at 1 hour 30 minutes, then the inning is reversed to the last completed inning.
- 8) Round Robin and Play-off games:
U13A & U15A: 5-run per inning maximum and 7th inning only, will be open
U19A: all innings are open
- 9) Time will commence immediately following the first warm up pitch.
The Umpire will turn to the scorekeepers and advise them time has commenced.
- 10) Run Ahead Rule (previously known as 'Mercy Rule') for **all** games:
15 runs after 3 innings, 10 after 3 1/2 innings if home team is ahead and 7 after 4 1/2 innings if home team is ahead.

- 11) Both scorekeepers will ensure the final game score is recorded correctly on the game summary score form. The Umpire will determine the official scorekeeper (Home Team) and advise him/her the start time of the game. The time will be noted on the official score sheet. The scorekeepers will sign the game summary score form, which is to be handed in at the Tournament Table, by the winning team scorekeeper, immediately after the game.
- 12) Round Robin standings will be determined by the following:
 - Win = 2 points
 - Tie = 1 point
 - Loss = 0 points
 - Win - Loss record.
 - Plus/Minus run totals to a maximum of 7 runs per game.
 - Plus/Minus base totals to a maximum of 30 per game.
 - Head-to-Head (where possible) otherwise Tournament Committee to decide.
- 13) Playoff games:
 - Higher seeded team gets choice of 'home' or 'away'.
 - No new inning to start after 1hour 15 minutes. If an inning has commenced, it must be continued until a winner is determined.
 - Ties must be played out by extra innings. International Tie Breaker will come into effect with the last out from the previous inning, starting at 2nd base.
- 14) Championship games: 7 innings
 - No time limit.
 - Ties must be played out by extra innings. International Tie Breaker will come into effect with the last out from the previous inning starting at 2nd base.
- 15) **This is a no protest tournament.**
Appeals to the umpires will be made properly without losing sight of good sportsmanship. Harassment of the umpires by players, coaches or spectators will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the ballpark.
- 16) Player of the Game Awards, during the Round Robin, will be handed out to U13A and U15A players. Coaches should pick up the Certificates that are handed to players at the Tournament Desk. Players may come to the Tournament Desk to pick up their Award.
- 17) Tournament Director may make any changes deemed necessary at any time without notice.
