



VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT FORM – HOUSE DIVISION

RMMSA is pleased to have your child be part of our **House Division!** RMMSA is a non-profit, volunteer-driven organization. Without volunteers, there would be no Association! As our kids grow, it is important to set examples for them. One of the most important examples one can give a child is the importance of giving the gift of time. By volunteering with RMMSA, you are demonstrating a commitment to your child, the community, and the sport of softball.

Part of the RMMSA House registration requirements is the participation in a minimum of two (2) Association Volunteer Hours (per registered child) scheduled by the Association within the current softball season, along with a cheque post-dated for **August 1 of the current year** in the amount of \$100 (per registered child). If you are unable to provide a cheque, cash is accepted but not preferred.

*The participation in these two (2) Association Volunteer Hours are in **addition** to the important time that parents put in to support their child's coach and team throughout the season. In other words, setting up fields, taking down/clean up of fields, scorekeeping, etc. for your child's team **are not** considered Volunteer Hours for the Association.*

How the Volunteer Commitment process works:

1. Register and pay for fees
2. Complete this Volunteer Commitment form (distributed by the Coaches)
3. Supply a signed cheque posted for **August 1 of the current year** in the amount of \$100 per child to the team's coach or manager along with this completed form
4. Throughout the season there will be plenty of opportunities to "work off" your volunteer commitments for the Association, such as but not limited to field prep for tournaments, warehouse cleanup, event setup/take down.
